"During the whole of the operations around Pozieres, from 21 July to 15 August 1916, Gunner Albertz was employed upon linesman duties. In carrying out these duties he was called upon to go out and repair and lay lines both by day and night under heavy shell fire. Owing in no small measure to the work so gallantly and well done by him when up with the Forward Observation Officer at Pozieres, communication was maintained practically continuously with the infantry."



"The Australian advance was preceded by several days of heavy rain which turned the shell-torn earth into a sea of thick mud. With rain still falling, the battle took place on 12 October 1917. Advancing at dawn, the attack to seize the neck of the Keiberg Ridge quickly floundered in the horrific conditions of the battlefield. The men were unable to keep up with the artillery barrage, some getting caught in the mud, while others vanished beneath it. Throughout the day, they were continuously fired on by enemy artillery, further adding to the misery and confusion of the battle. The attack at Passchendaele cost the 47th Battalion some 350 casualties, with around 100 dead. Among their numbers was Private Alex Bidice, who had been killed in action during his unit's advance on 12 October 1917." *Meagan Adams Australian War Memorial*



The first major action of the 1st Anzac Corps on the Western Front was the Battle of Pozieres Ridge, which was conducted from 23 July to 3 September 1916. While occupying the position known as Tom's Cut, the 15th Battalion was subject to intense bombing. On the morning of 9 August 1916, Walter was killed instantly by a German shell that landed directly on Tom's Cut.
