Sanananda was the scene of fierce and costly fighting. Australian and US troops reached the three enclaves of Buna, Gona and Sanananda in mid-November 1942 but early efforts were unsuccessful and costly. The 2/7th were flown to Popondetta to reinforce the units there in December.

When it became clear that frontal assaults were doomed, attacks on Sunananda were halted while Buna was overcome. The Japanese began to withdraw on 12 January 1943. The battle cost some 2,100 Allied casualties and the lives of more than 1,500 Japanese soldiers.



"At 5 a.m. July 22 we were into it – a bayonet attack on a ridge about 2,000 yards off through air thick with lead. The objective gained, but "Mulga" and his badly depleted party were ordered to clear a gap in the minefield to let our truck clear the wounded.

Two of his mates were badly shocked and temporary hopeless as a useful force, so he aided them to the comparative safety of a nearby shell hole, placing more work on his shoulders.

With these men safe, "Mulga" turned to his job in the face of heavy mortar fire. They got him." Sgt A. Campbell







During the Battle of the Bismarck Sea, 30 Squadron (Beaufighters) and U.S. aircraft attacked a Japanese convoy of eight transport ships and four destroyers, carrying 6,900 troops. Only 1,200 troops made it to Lae (2,700 were rescued at sea).

Bonny's Beaufighter crashed off the coast of New Guinea on 29 September 1944, and he and his navigator were captured. Their graves were discovered on 25 January 1945. Not a single member of 30 Squadron captured by the Japanese survived the war.




